



GENERAL RULES FOR POKER

1. No abusive, vulgar or aggressive language will be tolerated.
2. All games are table stakes. Cash does not play.
3. Protect your hand at all times.
4. An exposed card in either blind is a misdeal.
5. Only English may be spoken at the table.
6. No foreign chips or electronics devices are allowed on or around the table.
7. Verbal action in turn is binding.
8. No "String" betting.
9. Cards exposed to another active player during the course of a hand must be played face up and the 'show one show all rule' is in effect. Players who expose any part of their hand in a multi-way pot (three or more players) will not have a dead hand, but will receive one warning and be asked to leave for the day on the second infraction.
10. If leaving the game to go eat or to take a break, you are allowed 30 minutes to return to your seat and continue play. If you do not return once notified your spot will be given to the next person on the list.
11. Marking or damaging cards will be considered cheating and will be dealt with accordingly.
12. Floor Supervisor is to consider the best interest of the game and fairness as the top priority in decision making process. As such, these rules may be modified at the discretion of the Supervisor in the interest of fairness and equality. Management decisions are final.
